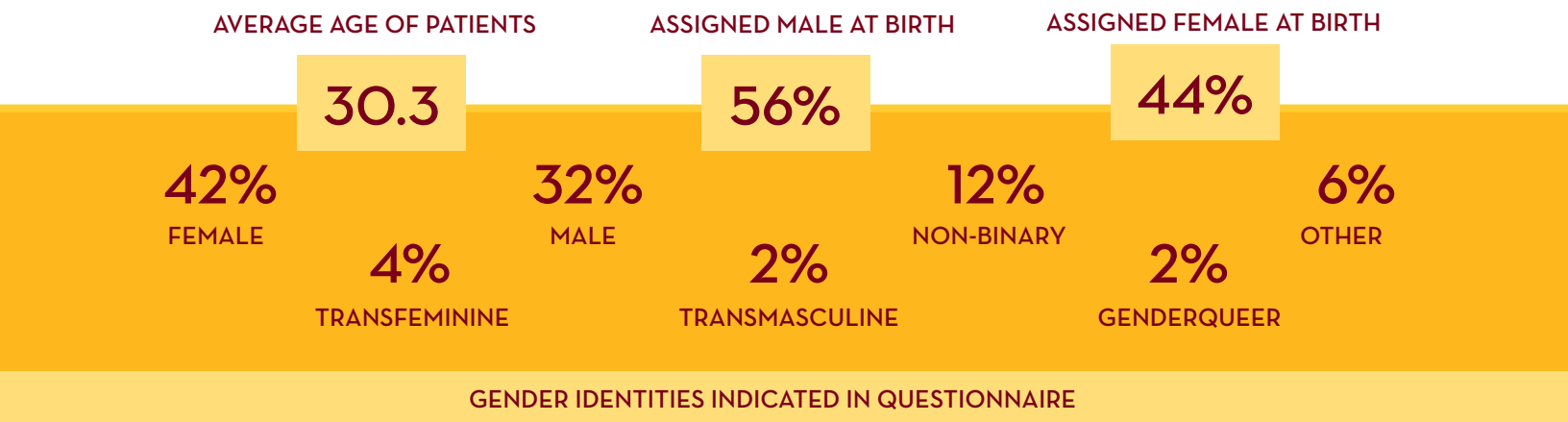


IMPLEMENTATION OF A GENDER-AFFIRMING HORMONE THERAPY PATIENT QUESTIONNAIRE IN A FAMILY MEDICINE CLINIC

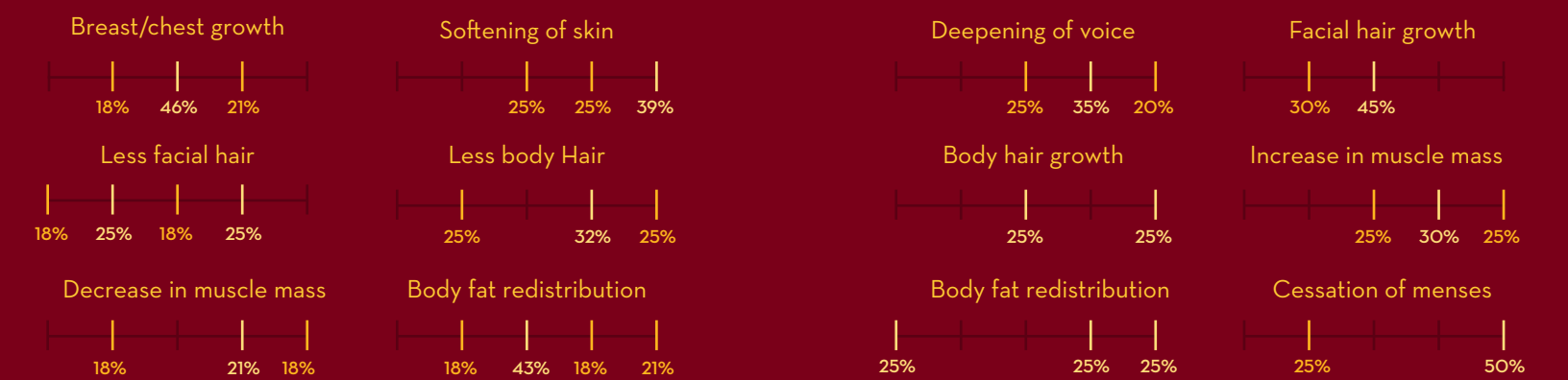


BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE

A standard component of care for patients receiving gender-affirming hormone therapy (GAHT) involves the review of self-reported progress regarding physical changes and side effects, typically conducted during clinical visits through direct physician-patient interviews. This project aims to integrate a preappointment, self-administered patient questionnaire to gather this information prior to the visit and assess its provider-perceived impact on appointment efficiency and utility in clinical decision-making.



Scales below based on a 1 through 5. 1 being, “No Change Yet”, and 5 being, “Reached Goal”.



INTERVENTIONS BECAUSE OF QUESTIONNAIRE

14	Order Labs	7	Change hormone medication dose	2	Recommend a lifestyle change
8	Schedule follow-up appointment to discuss their GAHT	3	Refer patient to another provider	0	Discontinue hormone medication
7	Start or recommend a new medication	2	Change hormone medication formulation
