II. Year 2 Questionnaire (Y2Q)

- ❖ We now have 3 years of data on Y2Q
- ♦ 67.8% of students responded to the survey
- ❖ Duluth experienced a decrease in student satisfaction, which was noted to be most likely as a result of 2 faculty leaving the program who were heavily involved and included a PBL based courses
- ❖ Interest in longitudinal data from the Year 2 Questionnaire to Graduation Questionnaire was an area of interest
- Questions: What are schools in the top quartile doing to address these topics? Are we making a statistically significant jump toward the goal over time?
